## Cutting Instructions: WOFLLOF = Width of Fabric/Length of Fabric

From the Morning Dew - 3 (A), cut:
-(2) $41 / 2 "$ (11.43cm) x WOF strips. Sub-cut (18) $41 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ (11.43cm) squares.
From the Little Vine - 1 (B), cut:
-(3) $411 / 2 "(11.43 \mathrm{~cm}) \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2 "(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$ strips.

From the Daisy Shadow - 1 (C), cut:
-(6) $21 / 2 "$ ( 6.35 cm ) x WOF strips. Sub-cut (96) $21 / 2 "(6.35 \mathrm{~cm})$ squares.
From the Forget Me Not-3 (D), cut:
-(3) $21 / 2 "$ " 6.35 cm ) x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) $21 / 2 "(6.35 \mathrm{~cm})$ squares.

## From the Country Path - 1 (E), cut:

-(11) $21 / 2 "(6.35 \mathrm{~cm}) \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (96) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2 "(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$ strips.

- (5) $21 / 2 "(6.35 \mathrm{~cm}) \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (68) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}(6.35 \mathrm{~cm})$ squares.

From the Cosmos Meadow - 3 (F), cut:

- (4) $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}(13.97 \mathrm{~cm}) \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 631 / 2$ " $(13.97 \mathrm{~cm} \times 162 \mathrm{~cm})$.
- (3) $51 / 2$ " $(13.97 \mathrm{~cm}) \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $51 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 571 / 2^{\prime \prime}(13.97 \mathrm{~cm} \times 147 \mathrm{~cm})$.

From the Daisy Shadow - 3 (G), cut:

- (4) $2^{\prime \prime}(5.08 \mathrm{~cm}) \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 601 / 22^{\prime \prime}(5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 154 \mathrm{~cm})$.
- (3) $2^{\prime \prime}(5.08 \mathrm{~cm}) \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " x $471 / 2 "$ ( $5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 121 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).
-(11) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}(6.35 \mathrm{~cm}) \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (164) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}(6.35 \mathrm{~cm})$ squares.
-(7) $21 / 2 "(6.35 \mathrm{~cm}) \times$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Forget Me Not-1 (H), cut:
-(3) $21 / 2 "$ ( 6.35 cm ) x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) $211 / 2 "(6.35 \mathrm{~cm})$ squares.


## Cutting Instructions - Continued:

From the Cosmos Meadow - 1 (I), cut:
-(2) $411 / 2 "(11.43 \mathrm{~cm}) \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (17) $41 / 2 "$ (11.43cm) squares.
From the Morning Dew-1 (J), cut:
-(4) $21 / 2 "(6.35 \mathrm{~cm}) \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (34) $21 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$ strips.
From the Daisy Shadow - 2 (K), cut:
-(6) $21 / 2 "$ ( 6.35 cm ) x WOF strips. Sub-cut (96) $21 / 12^{\prime \prime}(6.35 \mathrm{~cm})$ squares.
-(4) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}(6.35 \mathrm{~cm}) \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (34) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$ strips.
From the Lawn Games - 1 (Back), cut:
-(2) 65 " $(166 \mathrm{~cm}) \times$ WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the $65 "$ x 81 " ( $166 \mathrm{~cm} \times 206 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) back.

## Sewing Instructions:

Sew using a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise indicated.

1. Place (1) $21 / 2 "(6.35 \mathrm{~cm})$ Fabric C square on the left side of (1) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$ Fabric B strip, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance.
2. Place another $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}(6.35 \mathrm{~cm})$ Fabric $C$ square on the right side of the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$ Fabric B strip, right sides together (Fig. 3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 4).
3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make (48) Unit 1 strips total.

4. Repeat Steps $1-2$ and use (48) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$ Fabric E strips, (48) $21 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ ( 6.35 cm ) Fabric G squares and (48) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}(6.35 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) Fabric K squares to make (48) Unit 2 strips (Fig. 5).
5. Repeat Steps $1-2$ and use (48) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$ Fabric E strips, (48) $21 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ ( 6.35 cm ) Fabric K squares and (48) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ( 6.35 cm ) Fabric G squares to make (48) Unit 3 strips (Fig. 6).

6. Sew (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}(6.35 \mathrm{~cm})$ Fabric $D$ square to each end of (1) Unit 1 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to each side of (1) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}(11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$ Fabric A square lengthwise to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together to make (1) Unit 4 block (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (12) Unit 4 blocks total.
7. Sew (1) Unit 2 strip to the left end of (1) Unit 3 strip to make (1) Border Strip. Repeat to make (48) Border Strips total.
8. Sew (1) $2 \frac{1}{2} / 2$ ( 6.35 cm ) Fabric H square to each end of (1) Border Strip to make the top border. Repeat to make the bottom border. Sew (1) Border Strip to each side of (1) Unit 4 block lengthwise to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (12) Block One squares total.

9. Repeat Steps $1-2$ using (34) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$ Fabric J strips and (68) $21 / 2$ " ( 6.35 cm ) Fabric $G$ squares to make (34) Unit 5 strips (Fig. 9).
10. Repeat Steps $1-2$ using (34) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2 "(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$ Fabric K strips and (68) $21 / 2$ " ( 6.35 cm ) Fabric E squares to make (34) Unit 6 strips (Fig. 10).
11. Sew (1) Unit 5 strip to the top of (1) Unit 6 strip lengthwise as shown in Figure 11 to make (1) Unit 7 block. Repeat to make (34) Unit 7 blocks total.

12. Sew (1) Unit 7 block to the top and to the bottom of (1) $4 \frac{1}{2} / 2(11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$ Fabric I square to make (1) Block Two rectangle (Fig. 12). Repeat to make (17) Block Two rectangles total.

## Quilt Top Assembly: Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.

13. Sew (3) Block Two rectangles and (2) $41 / 2$ " Fabric A squares together end to end and alternating them to make (1) Sashing Row. Repeat to make (3) Sashing Rows total.
14. Sew (3) Block One squares and (2) Block Two rectangles together lengthwise and alternating them to make (1) Pieced Row. Repeat to make (4) Pieced Rows total.
15. Sew the (4) Pieced Rows and (3) Sashing Rows together lengthwise and alternating them to make the Center Block.
16. Sew (1) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 601 / 2^{\prime \prime}(5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 154 \mathrm{~cm})$ Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 471 / 2^{\prime \prime}(5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 121 \mathrm{~cm})$ Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
17. Sew (1) $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 631 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ( $13.97 \mathrm{~cm} \times 162 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $51 / 2 " \times 571 / 2^{\prime \prime}(13.97 \mathrm{~cm} \times 147 \mathrm{~cm})$ Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
18. Layer and quilt as desired.
19. Sew the (8) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF ( $6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF) Fabric $G$ strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
20. Bind as desired.
